Now many signs and wonders were regularly done among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. ACTS 5:12

When the disciples received the Holy Spirit and acted on His power, more people got saved. As Christians, no matter what we do, we need to understand that it is not our own skills, capabilities, or power that brings people to God. Rather, God's Spirit brings people to know Him. In this lesson, through what was happening in the book of Acts, we will discover how we can depend on the power of the Holy Spirit for the gospel to be proclaimed.

1 Believe God for miracles.

Now many signs and wonders were regularly done among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. ACTS 5:12

Before we can witness miracles in our own lives, we need to believe that God is able to make them happen. The Bible encourages us to live by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7). According to Hebrews 11:1, what is faith?	S

2 Point people to God.

¹⁴And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, ¹⁵so that they even carried out the sick into the streets and laid them on cots and mats, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them. ACTS 5:14,15

3 Persevere to proclaim the gospel.

And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they did not cease teaching and preaching that the Christ is Jesus. ACTS 5:42

Despite opposition, the early church grew, and the gospel
continued to spread. More and more people put their faith
in Jesus. Because we have received the Holy Spirit, we can
persevere to proclaim the gospel. How often and where did the disciples proclaim the gospel? What can we learn from this verse?

APPLICATION

- Do you believe that God can do miracles in your life and through you, even today? If you believe this is true, what's one specific thing you can do about it this week?
- In what area do you need to step out in faith? How can you point people to God through the way you live?
- To whom can you present the gospel to this week, and how do you think you can consistently share what God has done in your life?

PRAYER

- Thank God for how He works in our lives, and how He still does miracles today.
- Pray for faith to rise up in each of the members of your group. Believe God for signs, wonders, and miracles to abound in and through you so that more people may know and serve God.
- Intercede for family, friends, classmates, or colleagues who
 do not have a relationship with God yet. Pray that God
 would use you to proclaim the gospel boldly.
