SO WHAT

- How much do you rely on the Holy Spirit when sharing the gospel or when you are about to do something challenging in general?
- How have you been blessed or helped by prayer or worship?
- What can you consider as great things you have done because you were empowered by the Holy Spirit?

NOW WHAT

- With whom can you share the gospel through the power of the Holy Spirit this week? What do you plan to do?
- How much do you enjoy praying and worshipping God? Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal Himself to you in a new and fresh way as you pray and praise.
- What talents or skills can you offer to serve in church? What can you possibly accomplish when you are empowered by the Holy Spirit?

PRAYER

- Pray for the salvation of your loved ones and may they be established in the faith.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you afresh as you pray and worship regularly.
- Be open to the areas of ministry that the Holy Spirit might quicken you to serve in.

ACTS 10: 44-48 (READ ACTS 11:22-24 AS WELL.)

WHAT

Prayer must always be connected to the main source—the Holy Spirit. Without Him, prayer is powerless and misguided. When we pray, the Holy Spirit is alerted to guide and empower us in our petition and intercession. This was what the early Christians experienced as written in the Book of Acts. What happens when we pray with the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit gives us wisdom on how to share the gospel.

While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. ACTS 10: 44

Not only are we given the words to say as we share the
gospel, the Holy Spirit brings power in every message we
give. Why should we rely on the power of the Holy Spirit
instead of our own ability when sharing the gospel?

The Holy Spirit blesses us with spiritual gifts and enables us to worship.

²²News of this reached the church in Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas to Antioch. ²³When he arrived and saw what the grace of God had done, he was glad and encouraged them all to remain true to the Lord with all their hearts. ²⁴He was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord. ACTS 11: 22-24

Like Barnabas, we can fully yield to the Holy Spirit in prayer
and be used by God mightily in His kingdom. Allow the Holy
Spirit to fill you up everyday and be an instrument to reach
many people with the gospel. Share a story about someone
