SO WHAT

- How do we receive God's power? What does His divine power do for us (2 Peter 1:3)?
- What do our prayers have to do with God's power? How does the Bible describe the prayer of a person who has already been made righteous?
- What role does faith play in the demonstration of God's miraculous signs and wonders? Is your faith in God increasing everyday?

NOW WHAT

- In what ways can you serve as God's witness through the power of the Holy Spirit? Who can you share the gospel with this week?
- How can you develop a regular time for prayer and for His Word?
- In what situations can you be a conduit of God's power, even His miraculous signs and wonders? Step out in faith by praying for someone you know who is sick this week.

PRAYER

- Ask the Holy Spirit for more of His power in your life and that He will use you as a channel of His power for others especially to those who have no relationship with Jesus yet.
- Ask for more passion and hunger for prayer and God's Word.
- Pray in a way you have never done before. Begin to intercede for other people.

WHAT

Paul and Barnabas boldly shared the gospel and many people embraced it. Even if some people tried to speak against them to those who just came to know about Jesus, they stayed and courageously defended their faith. Perhaps because God validated their preaching with signs and wonders. Are signs and wonders still available for us today? How can we move in God's power?
