WARM-UP

WORD

"While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night, shall not cease."

GENESIS 8:22

(Read also **GENESIS 6:20-22.**)

God was grieved because of all the wickedness on earth. Only Noah and his family found favor in His eyes. Because of this, He told Noah to build a boat big enough to hold two of every kind of living thing because He was about to bring destruction on earth through a flood. But before the flood came, God also instructed Noah to take with him every sort of food that is eaten (Genesis 6:21). Even during a time of judgment, God secured the provision that would enable Noah to start all over again. The passage above is from God's promise that He will never again destroy all the living things on the ground and that His provision shall not cease. God assured Noah that His purpose for man still stands and His unceasing provision comes with it. Though in the form of a seed, this provision would sustain them. Today, let's look at some of the characteristics of the seed that God asked Noah to secure and store.

1 The seed that God provides is powerful.

The seed may appear small and insignificant, but it has the
power to endure every season. In spite of the tough external
conditions it is exposed to, the seed will not lose its ability to
grow and multiply. In the same way, if we are good stewards
of the seed God gives us today, then it represents a season of
harvest. We may be coming from a challenging situation, just
like Noah. But we have the assurance that God will continually
provide. It may be in the form of a seed, but we know that in
His perfect time, it will bear fruit. How have you experienced
the power of the seed in your life?

2 There is seed to store.

"Also take with you every sort of food that is eaten, and store it up. It shall serve as food for you and for them." **GENESIS 6:21**

God specifically instructed Noah to store up on *every sort of* food that is eaten. Bringing this "seed" into the ark only meant that they had to bring it out when the time came. We know that God provides our needs at the moment, but He has also made provision for our needs in the future. There are portions of His provision that we are to store. How do you apply this principle in your life?

3 There is seed to sow.

"Every moving thing that lives shall be food for you. And as I gave you the green plants, I give you everything." **GENESIS 9:3**

The green plants God created have the ability to produce seeds and, therefore, multiply. But the seeds will not multiply on their own. They have to be planted in the right soil and receive nourishment. Planting a seed involves cultivating the soil and providing whatever it needs to grow. It also means trusting that God will make it grow and bring about a harvest. Because farmers know the importance of sowing, they choose the best seeds to sow, with the belief that the best seeds will produce the best harvest in the future. What does Proverbs 3:9–10 tell us about using all that God gives us in a way that honors Him?

God's promise is that seedtime and harvest will not cease (Genesis 8:22). This is God's way for His provision to continue until the end of time. The seed represents God's provision for us and we are to faithfully steward this by storing and using it according to God's principles and for the purpose of honoring Him.

APPLICATION

- How do you respond in times of difficulty? Have you
 experienced an inability to act because of fear? Ask God to
 show you how you can respond in faith when you experience
 situations like this.
- What passages of Scripture do you know about God's provision? Write these down and what God is telling you through these passages.
- What practical things do you do to save and invest? What can you do to put the resources God has given you to good use?

PRAYER

- Thank God for His unceasing provision for you and your family.
 Pray for faith to look only to Him in all circumstances.
- Ask God to make you a good steward of everything He blesses you with. Ask God to mold your character so that you will not hold on to what you have, but that you would be generous in all occasions to accomplish His purpose for and through you.
- Pray for faith so that you can sow God's provision in your life, with the expectation that God will bring an increase and cause what you sow to multiply.
