What does the Bible say?

When you are about to do something new, would it not be easier if someone took the time to walk you through it? Oftentimes, the words "make disciples" intimidate us, but really, there is no need to be hesitant because God has promised that He will enable us to do what He called us to do. So, what is making disciples all about?

Making disciples is about helping people have a relationship with God.

"... baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son
and of the Holy Spirit . . ."

Matthew 28:19

To make a disciple is not to give a person some set of rules to follow. Rather it is showing him or her that receiving Jesus into his or her life is actually entering a relationship with Him. How does a relationship work? One needs to allot time to get to know the other person, to communicate with him or her, to share lives with that person. How does a person grow in relationship with God?

Making disciples is about teaching people to obey God's Word.

". . . and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. . . ."

Matthew 28:20

Disciple making is not just simply teaching principles for knowledge's sake but rather sharing the truth that produces obedience out of love and devotion to God. It is teaching people to hear from God and discern His will for themselves. Though God can speak through spiritual leaders and godly counsel, disciples should develop dependence unto God and not on people. In your life, how did you get to know and follow God's will?
